

# COLLECTING A URINE SAMPLE FROM YOUR CAT

## You will need ...

- ✓ A free Urine Collection Kit – drop by the clinic to pick one up, if you haven't already
- ✓ An empty litter tray, washed with hot water and disinfectant and dried

## When to collect

Overnight prior to your cat's appointment.

## How to collect:

- 🐾 Place the litter included in the Urine Collection Kit In your clean litter tray, this is a particular type of litter that will not absorb urine allowing you to collect a sample easily
- 🐾 Set out the litter tray and remove any other litter trays from the house *OR* if you have more than one cat, set up the cat you are collecting from in a room by themselves for the night with the litter tray you have just prepared
- 🐾 Once your cat has urinated in the tray, use the pipette included in the Collection Kit to extract a sample
- 🐾 Place the sample into the sterile urine container also included in the Collection Kit
- 🐾 Place the container in your fridge until it's time to bring it with you to your cat's vet appointment, dispose of the litter in the bin
